
Express Design Wizard


Create an embroidery design automatically from a picture.


This Wizard works best with clear pictures in a cartoon or coloring book style.


- Convert color areas into satin and fill stitches
- Trace picture outlines
- Create borders or appliqués around shapes in a picture
- 1. Go to the Create Tab and choose Express Design. You can choose Into Hoop which will create a design to fill the chosen hoop ExpressDesign PhotoStitch size or Into Rectangle where you can draw a rectangle with a specific size. ExpressDesign Into Hoop Click Into Hoop ExpressDesign Into Rectangle 2. In the next step, you can choose what Create Express Embroidery style you want on your embroidery; Create Express Trace Create Express Border Express Embroidery - A full color embroidery with satin and fill areas. Express Trace - Creates an outline of the picture Express Border - Creates a border around the enclosed areas in the picture. Choose Create Express Embroidery, click Next

	On the Export pop-up you also get additional choices under Optimize for Sewing. These are settings you can change in Configure.	Optimize for Sewing Combine Remove Overlap ColorSort Optimize Stitch Length: Options
18.	If you open Configure under the File menu and the Export Tab you can select your options. Removing the checkmarks for Combine and Color Sort helps if you want to decide when to do that manually before Export. This is very useful when working with Appliqué designs where you want to keep the number of color blocks for the technique steps. To create the stuffed animal, just embroider the design on a plain white fabric. Add a $\frac{5}{8}$ " (1.5cm) seam allowance around all the edges following thew shape of the animal. Place the embroidered fabric right sides facing with a plain fabric for the back. Sew them together with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " (6mm) seam allowance and leave an opening at the bottom to fill with fiberfill. Sew together by hand.
