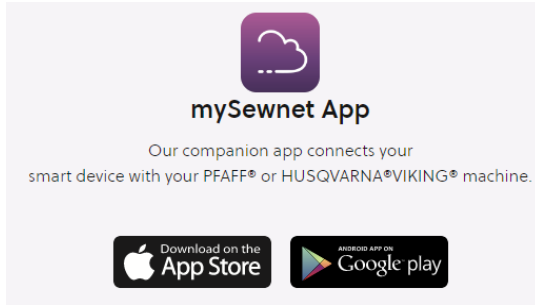

PhotoStitch - with mySewnet App

Turn any photo into an embroidery design by simply taking a picture using the PhotoStitch Feature within the mySewnet app. It'll automatically turn it into a ready-to-stitch design that can be sent directly to your mySewnet device or be saved in your cloud account.

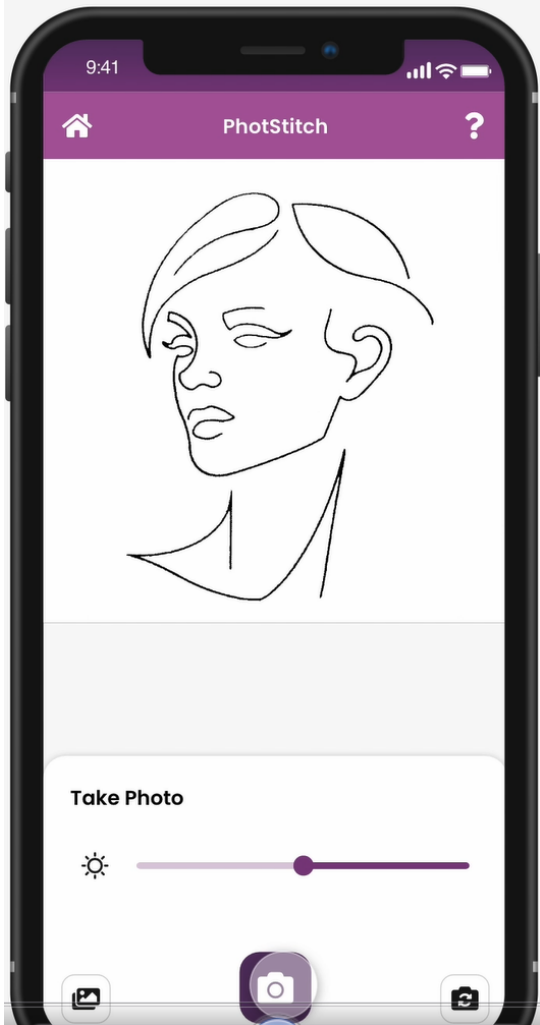

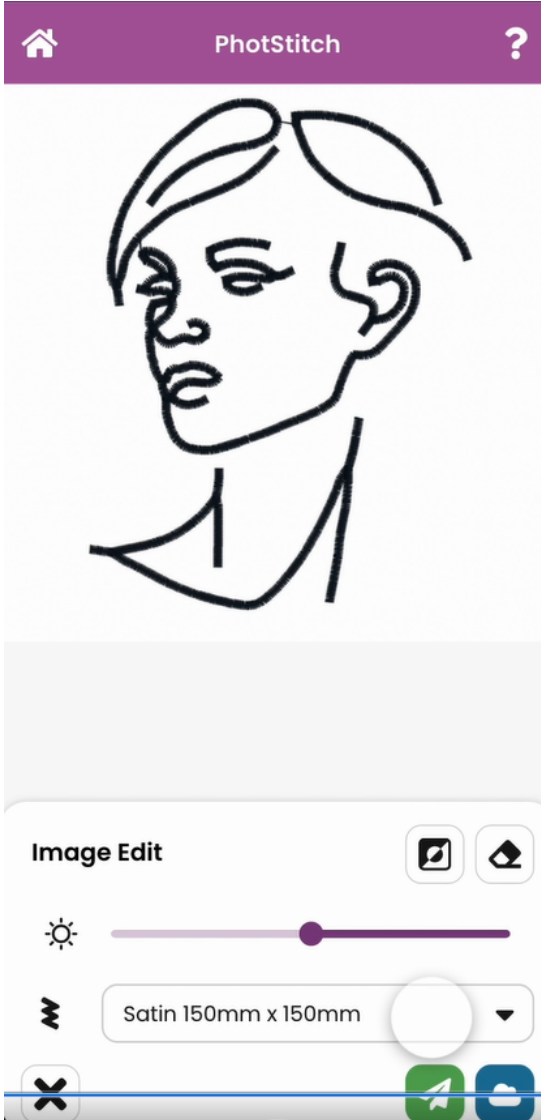


When you open the App you will have access to several different features.

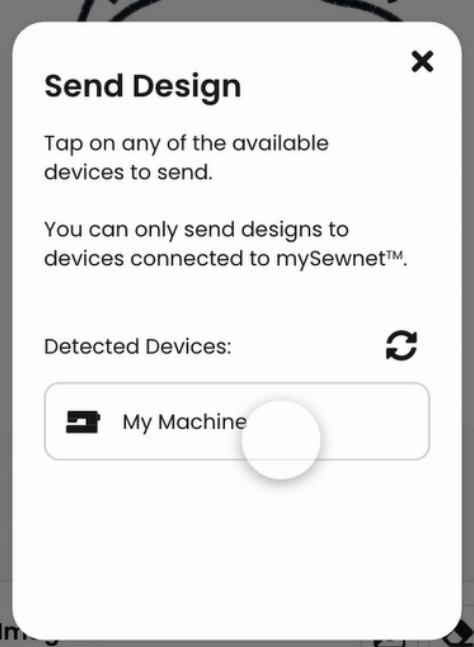
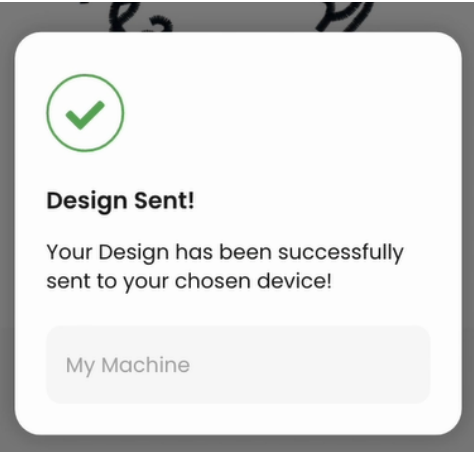
In this instruction we will look at PhotoStitch

Click on the PhotoStitch icon.



<p>3</p>	<p>This will open the camera on your phone/tablet.</p> <p>Now you can take a picture to digitize.</p> <p>This feature will work best on clear graphic pictures.</p>	
<p>4.</p>	<p>The default setting for creating a design is Scatter but there are 3 different stitch options to choose from in two sizes each.</p> <p>You can try which option works best for your image.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Scatter 80mm x 80mm Scatter 150mm x 150mm Satin 80mm x 80mm Satin 150mm x 150mm Line Art 80mm x 80mm Line Art 150mm x 150mm

<p>5.</p>	<p>In this case it is the Satin 150 x 150mm</p>	
<p>6.</p>	<p>There are also editing options available. You can Invert the image or use the eraser to remove object you do not want.</p>	
<p>7.</p>	<p>When you are happy with your embroidery. You can either send it directly to your mySewnet enabled machine or save it to your Cloud account for use later.</p>	

<p>8.</p>	<p>To see your machine in the list, make sure you are signed in with your mySewnet account in both the app and the machine.</p>	
<p>9.</p>	<p>Click on the machine you want to send the design to and the design will appear on the machine screen.</p>	
<p>10.</p>	<p>When you choose to Save to Cloud, you need to give the embroidery design a file name and click Save.</p>
