

Software Settings

Use the Preferences and Configure to set the universal behavior and look of mySewnet Embroidery Software.

<p>1.</p>	<p>Click on the File Menu to access the Preferences and Configure</p>	
<p>2.</p>	<p>Let's start with the Preferences: <i>These settings will be remembered when mySewnet Embroidery is closed and reopened.</i></p>	
<p>3.</p>	<p>Remove Overlap When Combining Embroideries:</p> <p>When this option is selected, overlapping areas of embroidery are removed, so that there is no build-up of stitching where embroideries overlap. This is used for the Combine All and Combine Selected functions. This option is initially selected.</p> <p>Spelling:</p> <p>When Check Spelling is selected, text entered in the Letters box on the Letter</p>	<p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Remove Overlap When Combining Embroideries</p> <p>Spelling</p> <p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Check Spelling English US ▾</p>

	<p>tab is checked for unrecognized words in the selected language. Spelling is also checked in the Letter Properties dialog box that appears when you right-click lettering on the work area. Additionally, new sentences are capitalized. To change the language, click the drop-down arrow and choose the desired language from the list.</p> <p>Deselect Check Spelling if you prefer not to check spelling.</p>	
<p>4.</p>	<p>Appliqué Piece Margin</p> <p>Use the Appliqué Piece Margin settings in Preferences to override the initial appliqué placement settings for lettering, SuperDesigns, Frames and Flourishes.</p> <p>Override margin width</p> <p>Override the appliqué placement margin for the selected design, using the width set here instead. Set the margin for appliqué placement relative to the selected shape from -10mm to 10mm. The initial value is 1.0mm.</p> <p>Override Match Placement Line</p> <p>Override the setting for Match Placement Line in the selected design.</p>	<p>Appliqué Piece Margin</p> <hr/> <p>Apply my settings for Appliqué Piece Margin, overriding the initial settings for lettering, SuperDesigns, Frames and</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Override margin width: 1.0 mm <input type="button" value="▲▼"/></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Override Match Placement Line</p>
<p>5.</p>	<p>In the Configure menu, you have the information about your mySewnet account all the settings for the appearance and import/export</p>	
<p>6.</p>	<p>In the mySewnet Tab you will find your mySewnet account. This is also where you sign in and out.</p> <p>You need to be signed in to have access to your level of Subscription.</p>	

7.	There are also links to mySewnet.com where you can Register an account, reset your password or Manage Your account	Register if you don't have a mySewnet™ Account. Reset your password if you've forgotten it. Manage my Account.
8.	Under My Computer, you need to activate your computer. You can also set a specific name for your computer that will show up when you send embroideries within mySewnet.	
9.	You will find several settings under Utilities.	
11.	You can create your own threads in mySewnet™ Thread Cache.	
12.	You can create your own database of the various threads you have in your stash or even create your own thread by adding the information..	

13.	This button will check your version of the software and if there are any updates available.	
14.	If you have personalized your settings in the software you can make a back-up to store them in case you need to make an update and then restore it. It will be saved as a .zip file	
15.	Restore will open the .zip file and restore the settings of the system.	
16.	This is a shortcut to the Quick Font feature. It can be used as a file type in the embroidery machine or as a file in mySewnet Embroidery.	
17.	This button will set-up the connection to a machine that uses the connect module through cable or USB.	
18.	This button will reset all modules in the embroidery software. Perfect if you have done a change in the appearance of your software that you're not happy with or changed a view by mistake.	
19.	This will reset the file association.	

20. You will get a list of format you can reset. The most common is the mySewnet Embroidery that will save your embroidery files as mySewnet .vp4 and .vp3
