

Easy Table Runner From Charm Pack



Project Description

This table runner is easy to make, you will use the precuts included in the box. They are 5x5” precuts, also called Charm pack size.

Here is everything you need to complete this project.

Included in the box:

- 20 light green squares 5x5”
- 19 medium green squares 5x5”
- Fabric for binding 3½ strips 2” wide

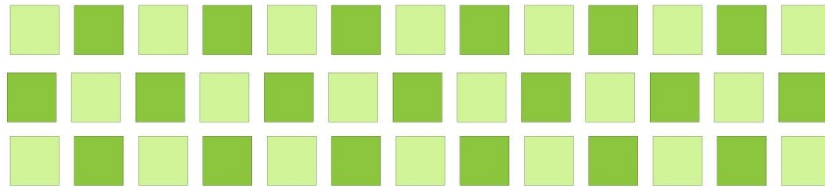
Materials needed to complete the project:

- Sewing thread
- Fusible thin batting same size as finished table runner
- Fabric for backing size of finished table runner plus 1” (2,5cm) all around

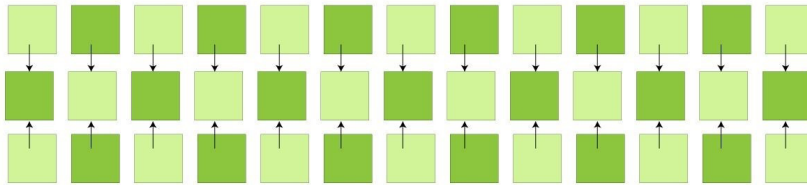
Project Instructions: (add photos next to steps)

Cut out the backing and batting. The backing should extend at least 1” (2,5cm) on all sides of the finished table runner. The batting should be cut to the same size as the backing.

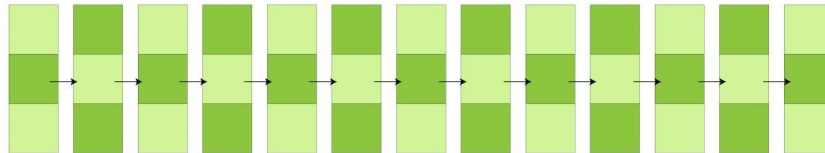
1. Lay out the patches in the right order, see image below for clarity



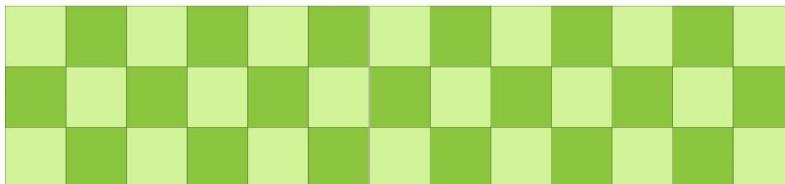
2. Sew the patches together in rows (columns) Press the seam allowances towards the darker fabric.



3. Sew the rows (columns) together. Take care to match the seams between the squares. Press the seam allowances open or to one side.



4. Now it should look like this:

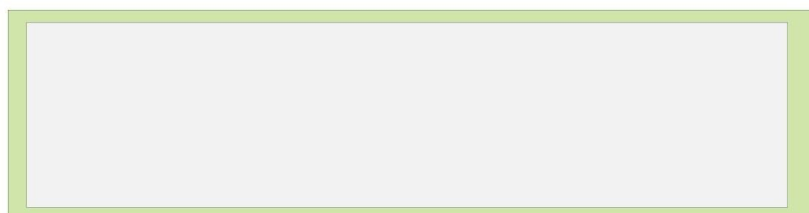


Adding backing and batting:

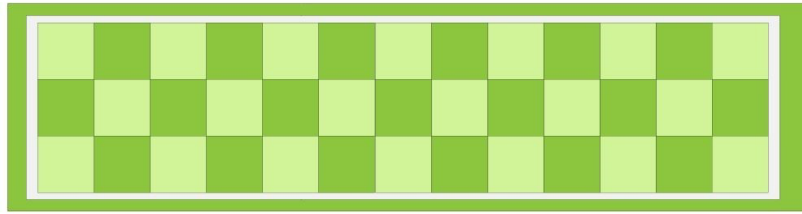
5. Put the backing on the table, wrong side up.



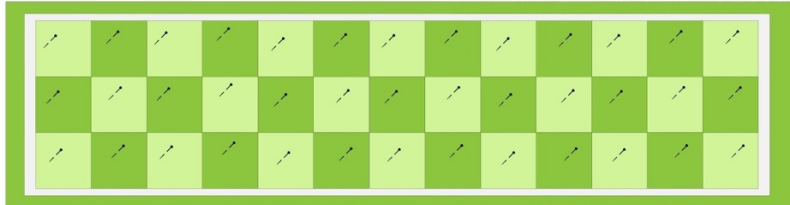
6. Place batting on top and fuse in place following the manufacturer's directions



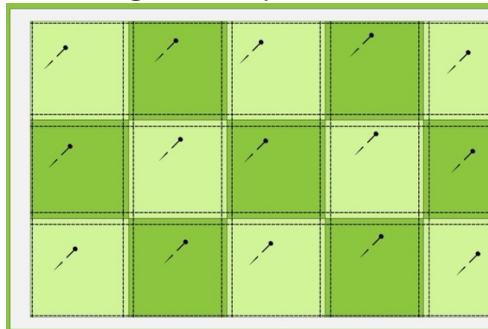
7. Place the quilt top right side up on the batting.



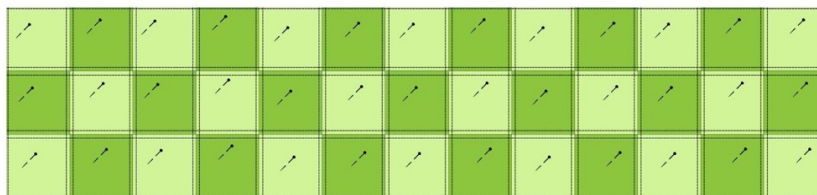
8. Pin in place through all layers.



9. Stitch lines on both sides of the squares horizontally and vertically. Use the presser foot as a guide. Topstitch close to the edge of the quilt to hold the layers together.



10. Cut the excess batting and batting away close to the edge.
