





mySewnet Library - Subscription for Embroidery Designs



With a subscription to mySewnet Library and a mySewnet enabled machine, you have access to all designs in the Library and can use them as much as you like as long as you have an active subscription.

The designs will be sent/saved in an encrypted .evp3 format. That means that your mySewnet enable machine will check if you have a subscription before you can stitch out.





You can also send the designs to mySewnet embroidery Software to edit them further before stitching out. Sign up for a subscription on mysewnet.com to get access to Library.








<p>6.</p>	<p>There is also the possibility to Filter by Design Size if you are looking for a specific minimum or maximum size or Color Block Count, which is very useful if you are looking for a monochrome design etc.</p>	
<p>7.</p>	<p>Filter on Flowers and find one that you like. This is #100443003</p>	
<p>8.</p>	<p>You will see the Name given to the design.</p> <p>The file name, which is what will show when you save or send the design.</p> <p>Number of colors and stitches,</p> <p>Height and width.</p>	

<p>9.</p>	<p>If you click on “Learn How to Stitch This Design” you will automatically scroll down to the thread color list on the design page.</p> <p>If there are technique steps available they will show in the list.</p>	
<p>10.</p>	<p>If there is an instructions available it will be shown under Documents.</p> <p>The technique included in the design is added as a searchable tag if you want to find designs with the same technique.</p>	
<p>11.</p>	<p>When you have a subscription, you have several options when you want to use the design:</p>	
<p>12.</p>	<p>Send to mySewnet enabled device This will show you the list of devices you are logged in on. Like your computer with the software or any embroidery machine. When you click on a device this will send the embroidery directly to the screen of your software or machine.</p> <p>The design is sent in the encrypted .evp3 format and is only available for stitch out when you have an active subscription.</p>	

<p>13.</p>	<p>You can also choose to upload the embroidery design to your cloud to use later. It will be stored in your 100Mb cloud storage in the Library folder.</p>	
<p>14.</p>	<p>It will be stored in your 100Mb cloud storage in the Library folder. The name of the file will be the part number visible in the information section.</p>	
<p>15.</p>	<p>Even if you have a subscription, you might want to own specific designs. This is also possible. You can add it to cart and make a purchase.</p>	
<p>16.</p>	<p>Proceed to check out and you will see a Shopping Cart Overview with a summary of your designs.</p>	
<p>17.</p>	<p>You will also have the possibility to choose in which format the design will be saved to your cloud. And you can choose your preferred design format.</p>	
<p>18.</p>	<p>There are several different formats available for different embroidery machine brands. You can always download the design again in a different format if you choose.</p>
